## Rubber Chicken Catapultin' Contest

### Rules:

Catapult should be less than 3ft tall when at rest (catapult arm under minimum tension).

One catapult entry per den.

Catapult should be designed and built by the boys, except when the use of power tools is necessary.

Catapult MUST be able to be triggered without having someone in the way of the launching arm.

Catapult must be able to launch a rubber chicken (approx 2 ounces) 20 feet and land in the target area.

Each catapult team will have 3 minutes to complete 5 launches to score points.

The team with the highest score will win.

Each launch will be triggered by a single boy with no other boys within 6 feet for safety.

### Scoring:

The Target will be a 6 ft circle with a large bowl in the center.

The Bowl will be approx 12 inches in diameter and approx 5 inches deep.

Each rubber chicken to land in the bowl will score 2 points.

Each rubber chicken to land in the 6ft circle and not in the bowl will score 1 point.

### Additional Awards:

Most Creative

The most unique out of the ordinary design for a catapult.

Most Authentic

The comparison will be the [Mangonel](#) style catapult.
